## 11. If elected District Attorney of York County, I have several goals.

I will fight the Opioid crisis by reunifying our separated York County Drug Task Force and York City Police Drug Investigations. Under our current District Attorney and because of my opponent, the York City Police Department and the York County Drug Task Force work separately to combat drug crime in York County. This is not the optimal use of our resources, not the best way to share or use intelligence or to fight drug dealers and it could endanger police officers because of inadequate deconfliction procedures. I will also look for ways to expand our Drug Treatment Courts. Finally, I will use every weapon in my arsenal to convict drug dealers and put them behind bars.

I will be a Voice for All Victims of Crime. I will create a Child Predator Unit with existing resources and/or grant funds, to combat those who would prey upon our precious children. I also value our Seniors and am concerned about their physical and financial well-being, so I will start a Senior Abuse Unit with existing resources and/or grant funding. This unit will investigate property and identity theft cries against Seniors and physical abuse and neglect of Seniors. Any changes will be as the result of redistribution of current resources and/or the acquisition of grants and will not increase the office's budget. I will partner with all stakeholders, both public and private, to further the ends of justice for those who are victims and to achieve prevention of crime where possible.

I will improve in-house training in the District Attorney's Office so that prosecutors are court-room ready and staff attorneys feel supported. The current District Attorney's staff has a rather high turnover rate and it is my goal to create an environment where attorneys feel they are a part of a team, where senior counsel are accessible and able to mentor and assist and ultimately, where persons will choose to remain and become career prosecutors. We will lose some attorneys to private practice but my goal is to keep their experience in the District Attorney's Office.

I hope to bring Central Court to York County. I have seen this model operate successfully in many Pennsylvania Counties. It allows preliminary hearings to be scheduled for a set day each week at the courthouse, so that assistant district attorneys, defense counsel, law enforcement and victims/witnesses to be present where a resolution may be obtained, if possible. This allows lower level offense cases to move swiftly through the system, making Court operations more efficient and freeing the Court's limited time for more serious cases, that are more likely to go to trial.

In summary, through my 27-plus years of experience in criminal prosecutions in 38 Pennsylvania counties, I hope to make York County safer for all its citizens.


