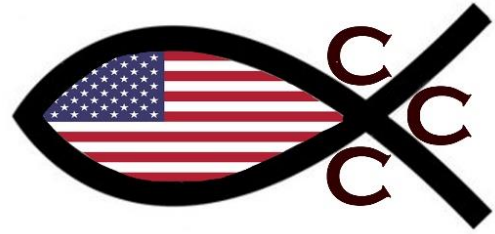

Dear Senator Toomey,

In behalf of York County Action and Conservative Christian Center, it is my pleasure to invite you to present our 2017 "Statesman of the Year" award to our Congressman, Scott Perry along with delivering appropriate remarks about the challenges you face in this Congress, at our annual breakfast at the Country Club of York (1400 Country Club Rd, York, PA 17403) on Saturday morning, September 30 at 8:30 AM.

Congressman Perry has confirmed his availability on this date but has also graciously provided a backup date for your convenience of October 7.

We will appreciate your letting us know at your very earliest convenience whether you can attend the September 30 or the October 7 date so that we can release the date not needed but being held for us by Congressman Perry and by the Country Club of York.

Congressman Perry's nomination as "Statesman of the Year" is subject to a final vote of the leadership of both breakfast sponsors, York County Action (e-newsletter) and Conservative Christian Center but we anticipate a unanimous agreement.

Congressman Perry will join past recipients of the Statesman of the Year Award: his colleague Congressman Lloyd Smucker (awarded when he was a state legislator), his former colleagues in the state legislature, Representatives Seth Grove and Will Tallman, and York County Commissioner Chris Reilly.

The Country Club of York has been the location for a number of years for this annual fundraising event of York County Action, now joined by Conservative Christian Center as a co-sponsor.

Proceeds from the breakfast will be used to pay for the distribution of a 2017 Election "Value Voters Guide" such as the one

printed and distributed for the May GOP primary at church services the two weekends before the primary and at polling places on election day. Most voters viewed this free guide as the most valuable handout of any given to them on their way into the polling place and so stated very clearly.
