Note for Judicial Candidates. We realize that some candidates will tell us that they cannot answer some or all questions because, they claim, this will disqualify them from hearing future cases. We do not agree. First, we have actually read the PA Supreme Court decision which guides this topic, a lawsuit brought by Action of PA and the PA Family Institute. There is no such prohibition on answering the questions we have asked. Second, we have privately conferred in the creation of these Voter Guide questions, with attorneys including several who went on to win a seat as a Judge. If you do not answer a question that is counted as a minus, and if you do not answer any questions you earn a "D" rating.


